

Detail Services under Single Roof

Enrolments, Demographic & Biometric details of the resident can be carried out through Aadhar Kendras (AKs) / Permanent Enrolment Centers (PECs) across India. PVC card printing and e-Aadhaar printing facility are also provided to the resident through AKs/PECs.

Aadhaar authentication and e-KYC services are available to different sectors of the industry ranging from Banks, Insurance companies, Government Organizations, Passport Offices, Airports, Depository Participants, Payment Gateway Provider, etc.

Following additional services are available to the service providers:

Verify Aadhaar Number: This will enable service providers and Aadhaar number holders to verify if the Aadhaar number is valid and is not deactivated

Verify Email/Mobile Number: Aadhaar number holder's registered mobile number is essential to access Aadhaar online services as well as Aadhaar enabled benefits. Residents can verify their already registered email address and mobile number

Lock/Unlock Biometrics: Aadhaar number holders can secure their biometric authentication by locking their biometrics. Once locked, same cannot be used by anyone for authentication. Residents can unlock their biometrics before any biometric authentications transaction.

Check Aadhaar & Bank Account Linking Status: : Aadhaar holders can check if their Aadhaar is linked to their bank account. Aadhaar Linking status is fetched from NPCI Server. Under any circumstance, UIDAI shall not be responsible or liable for the correctness of the displayed status. Further, UIDAI is not storing any information fetched from NPCI server.

CSC Scheme

Common Services Centers (CSCs) are a strategic cornerstone of the Digital India programme. They are the access points for delivery of various electronic services to villages in India, thereby contributing to a digitally and financially inclusive society.

The CSC is a strategic cornerstone of the National e-Governance Plan (NeGP), to introduce e-governance on a massive scale.

The CSCs would provide high quality and cost-effective video, voice and data content and services, in the areas of e-governance, education, health, telemedicine, entertainment as well as other private services. A highlight of the CSCs is that it will offer web-enabled e-governance services in rural areas, including application forms, certificates, and utility payments such as electricity, telephone and water bills. In addition to the universe of G2C services, the CSC Guidelines envisage a wide variety of content and services that could be offered as listed below:

- Agriculture Services (Agriculture, Horticulture, Sericulture, Animal Husbandry, Fisheries, Veterinary)
- Education & Training Services (School, College, Vocational Education, Employment, etc.)
- Health Services (Telemedicine, Health Check-ups, Medicines)
- Rural Banking & Insurance Services (Micro-credit, Loans, Insurance)
- Entertainment Services (Movies, Television)
- Utility Services (Bill Payments, Online bookings)
- Commercial Services (DTP, Printing, Internet Browsing, Village level BPO).

The Scheme creates a conducive environment for the private sector and NGOs to play an active role in implementation of the CSC Scheme, thereby becoming a partner of the government in development of rural India.

AADHAAR CARD PRINTING (PLASTIC AADHAAR CARD): As per UIDAI notification, all CSCs have been extended with a facility to print Plastic Aadhaar Cards leveraging e-KYC. Accordingly, 3,765 CSCs have delivered PVC Aadhaar Card service across 27 States & UTs in May 2016. During the period from April 2015 to May 2016, 34,04,910 PVC Aadhaar Cards have been printed through the CSC network.

Scale of the Aadhaar Kendras The setting and scale up of AKs is expected to be demand driven. As more and more applications roll out on Aadhaar, it is expected that the need for such centres will increase. Update of Aadhaar data, including biometric updates of children at 5 and 15 years of age, is also a permanent need of the residents, which the AKs will meet. In terms of its geographical spread, besides other locations, at least each Gram Panchayat in rural areas, and each municipal ward in the urban centres in the country could be an indicative service area for the AK. Where required, a mechanism for allotment of AK locations amongst multiple AKRs in a state, as well as other details of engagement of such AKs with the state government shall be clearly defined in due course. Nature of Aadhaar Kendras The full set of Aadhaar services for the resident are expected to be made available from Aadhaar Kendras. Depending on the type of Kendra, services offered would range from part of the services available to the full set of services available. The Aadhaar services would be in addition to all services being provided, and hence would remain viable for the service provider. AKR may set up exclusive Aadhaar Kendras, if they so desire. Aadhaar Kendras are expected to be permanent in nature.

Future Prospects The UIDAI may, at a future date, roll out premium and outreach services. Aadhaar Kendras would be the preferred location for the roll out of such services. For any additional resident facing services released by the UIDAI, where feasible, the same would be extended through the Aadhaar Kendras. All CSCs across the country can start PEC and only need the Aadhaar kit (Biometric and Iris scanner) and a certified operator.
